### **Teaching and Learning for the Upcoming Year**

Our staff attended professional development this summer in CGI Math. (Cognitively Guided Instruction) CGI is based on research that shows that children come to school with rich informal systems of mathematical knowledge and problem-solving strategies that can serve as a basis for learning mathematics with understanding. A major goal of CGI is to help teachers build on this informal mathematical knowledge so that they understand the new ideas they are learning. Because this method of teaching is innovative, CGI offers classroom teachers help in understanding how children's mathematical ideas develop. The focus is on children's thinking, not on specific teaching procedures or curriculum materials. For more details:

As part of our learning and teaching we will continue to use and expand brain-based student engagement strategies. (TTYP -turn to your partner, write your answer, draw your answer, and collaborate to explain many ways....) We will be working to expand writing even more across all content areas.

We also had some staff attend CKH Training, Capturing Kids' Hearts staff development, focuses on teacher-student relationships, student engagement, attentiveness, achievement, collaboration, and discipline, so we are excited to continue our learning in the area of CKH also.

### **School Hours-First Day of School of K-5 is August 25<sup>th</sup>   Preschool's first day of school is September 8th**

School hours are 8:35 A.M.-3:20 P.M. for grades K-5, Preschool hours are 8:30-11:30 A.M. Class and 12:30-3:30 P.M. Class. **We want all students to arrive to school by 8:25 A.M.** Being on time is very important for all students because when students arrive late it takes time to restate morning expectations and news and takes away from teaching and learning. Students need to be in their classrooms ready to learn when the 8:35 tardy bell rings. If students are walking in the door at 8:35 they are counted tardy. I appreciate your hard work to get all students to school in time. Please plan ahead for traffic and weather delays. We do have an early dismissal every Wednesday at 1:50 P.M. We do not have an early dismissal the first day of school though.

Fees are \$10 for Kindergarten and \$20 for 1<sup>st</sup> thru 5<sup>th</sup> grades.
