

SNOWBALL FIGHT



We're having a snowball fight for **Box Tops for Education!** Don't be alarmed, it is not a real fight but it is a real way to help raise money for our school. Collect Box Tops from hundreds of participating items, attach them to the snowball collection sheet and turn them in to your teacher. These sheets buy your class ammunition or snowballs to throw at other classes. Here's how it works. For every 10 Box Tops that your class collects, you will receive one paper "snowball" that your class can "throw" at another class. (These will be distributed weekly.) Preschool through 2nd grade can throw at each other and 3rd through 5th grades can throw at each other. We won't actually be throwing these snowballs. We will be stapling them to the bulletin board in the library by the class you chose to throw it at. This is called a "reverse" contest because instead of trying to get the most snowballs, **the class with the LEAST amount of snowballs on their bulletin board space wins!** This means your class needs to collect the most Box Tops so you can get more snowballs to protect your class. There will be one winning class in the Preschool through 2nd grade group and another winning class in the 3rd through 5th grade group. The contest will begin immediately and end February 12th when we'll announce who is the "King of the Snow Mountain". Have fun and good luck!
